## PROJECT PROFILE

PTTEP is the national oil and gas exploration and production company of Thailand, headquartered in Bangkok. PTTEP Australasia operates the Montara oil field and the prospective Cash Maple gas condensate field in the Timor Sea.

Infinity Offshore was mobilized to provide project engineering, diving supervisory and offshore construction management services for a campaign to repair a defective component on the Skua 11 subsea Christmas tree in 80 m of water using saturation divers.

The main services provided to the client were:

- Interface management between PTTEP and Vessel Contractor;
- Originating and review of procedures, designs, drawings and plans;
- Supporting procurement operations;
- Project scheduling and reporting; and
- Owners Engineers for Offshore Operations.


The vessel mobilized to the field in July 2017 out of Broome, WA.

Skua 11 was repaired in just over 12 days including a successful pressure test and function test before completing several other opportunity scopes of work set by the client.

All told, 27 days were spent in the field with all scopes completed successfully, zero injuries and zero incidents from operations.

Following the successful offshore campaign at the end of the project, the client was able to re-start production from the Skua 11 well safely and cleanly.
